Did you know that....

- Children as young as age 2 begin to classify differences in gender and race.
- Children as young as age 3 are susceptible to believing stereotypes.
- Children at age 5 understand cultural identity and can pick out stereotypes.
- Children at age 9 believe stereotypes are correct unless they experience a major life experience to the contrary.
